

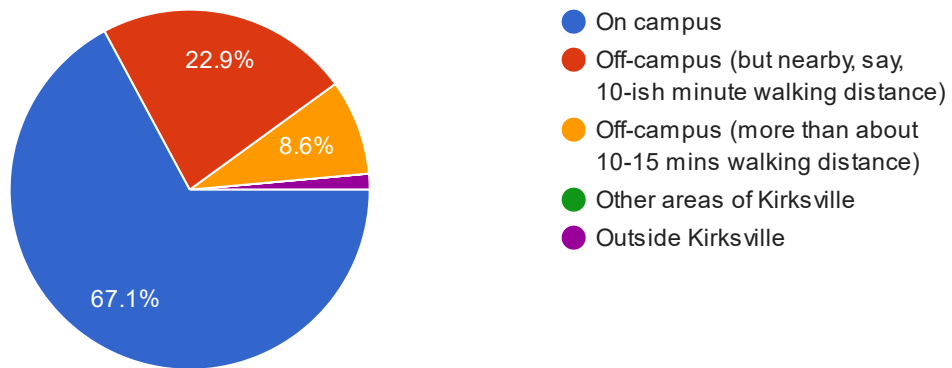

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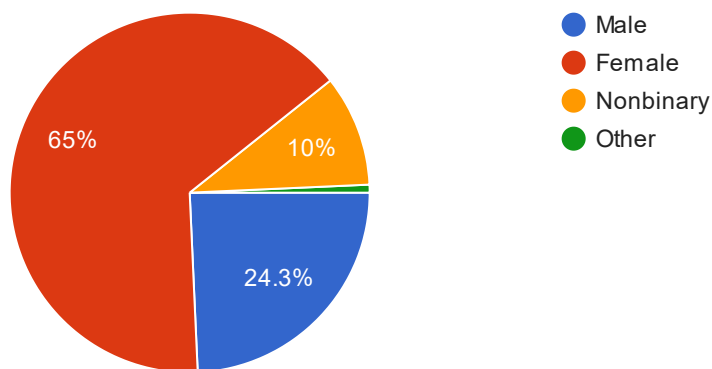

What is your gender identity?

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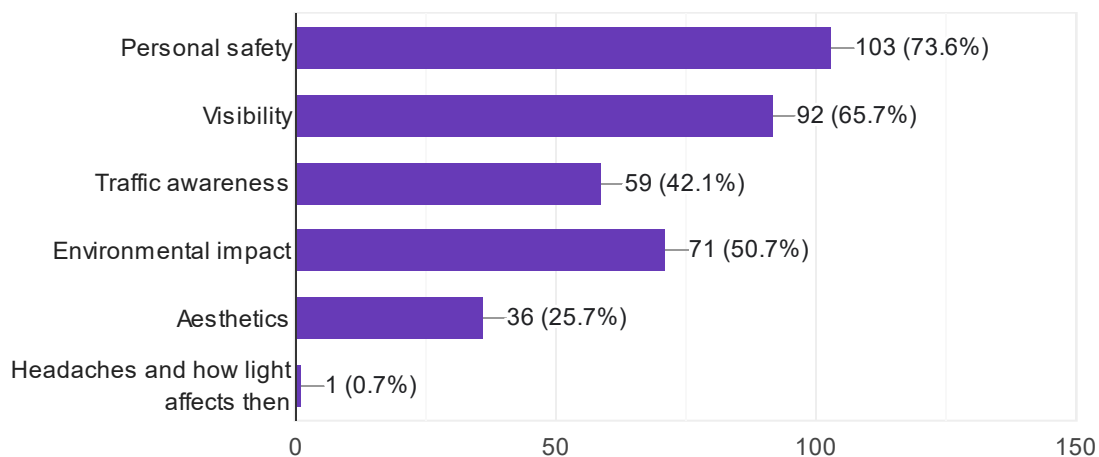

What are your primary concerns with lighting on-campus? Check all that apply.

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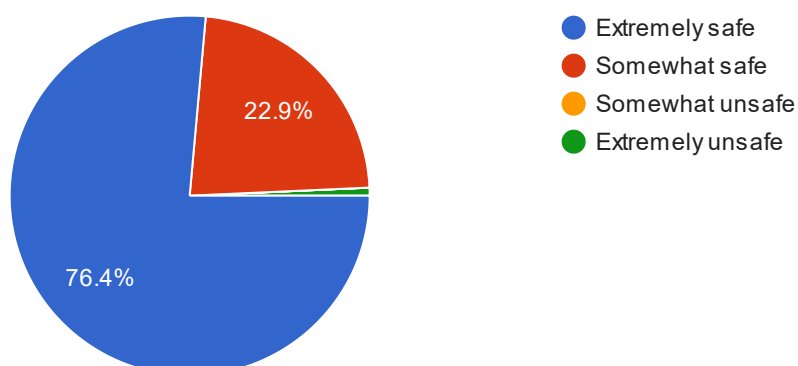

How safe do you feel walking on campus during the day?

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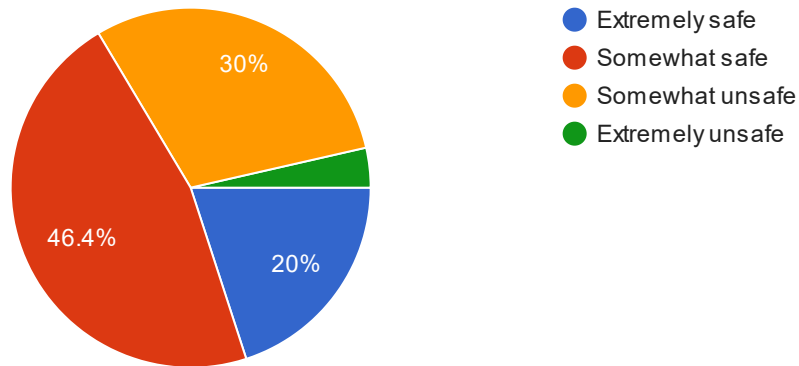

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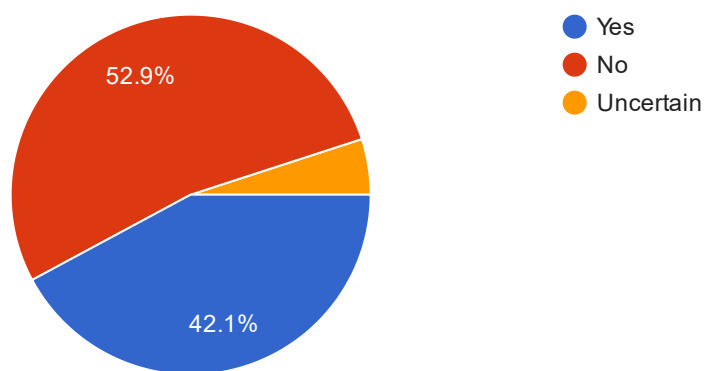

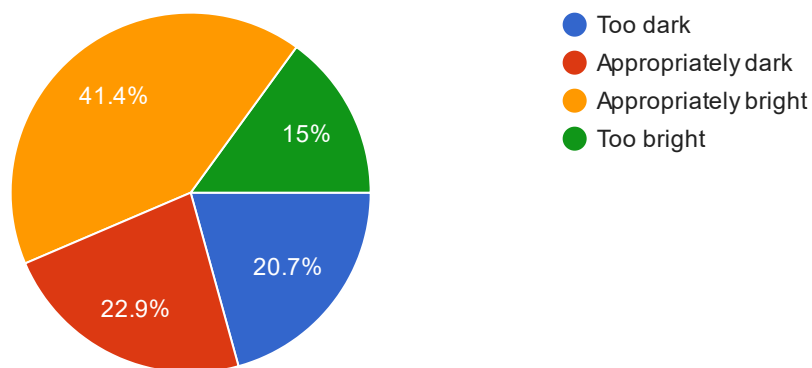


We would like you to rate the quality of outdoor lighting based on different criteria in the next few questions.

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First, rate the **intensity** of outdoor lighting on campus:

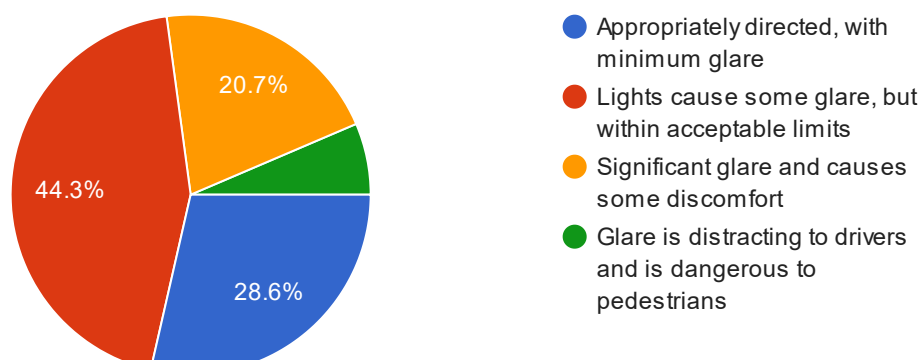

Rate the **directionality** of nighttime lighting fixtures outside or around your residence.

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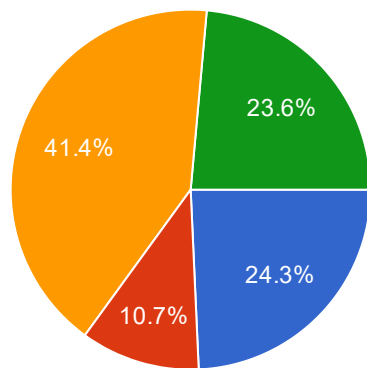

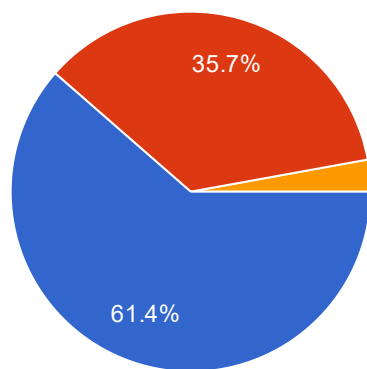


- I have not noticed color differences in lights

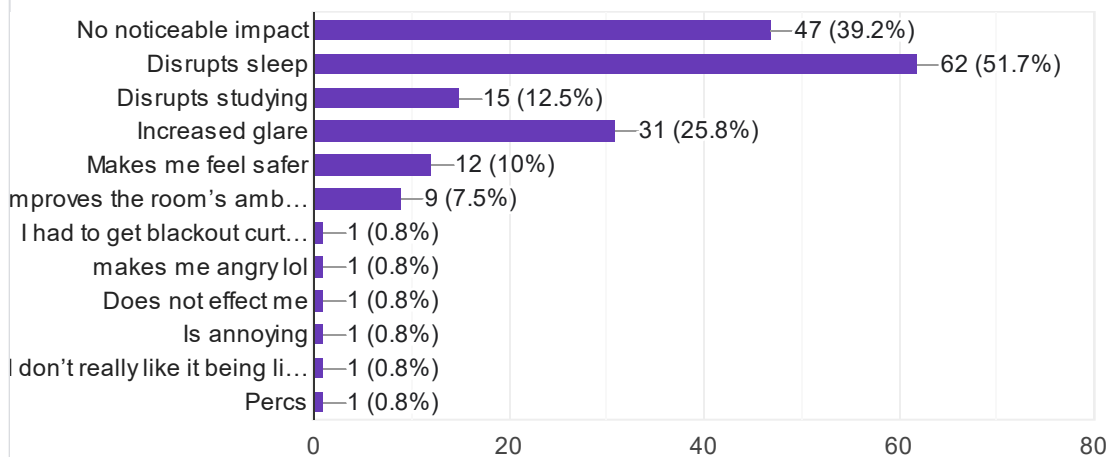
